The Pössnitzberg winery

During the past three years, 1.6 million Euros of investments have been pumped into the Tscheppe winery in Pössnitzberg. The restructuring included all areas: vineyards, cellars, and facilities for visitors.

Presentation rooms, a cellar for wine rarities and apartments for visitors were built according to plans of the G2plus group of architects (Martina and Norbert Grabensteiner). They offer a contemporary environment for visits as well as work, surrounded by one of Styria's most beautiful landscapes.

The rare wine cellar of the Tscheppe winery contains all current wines and a selection of mature and rare bottles from the Pössnitzberg and Czamillonberg sites for tasting and for sale. The potential of these vineyards can be clearly understood from tastings of wine from the 1970s and even beyond.

The winery is open to the public Monday to Saturday, 9am to 5pm, from March to November also on Sundays and bank holidays from 10am to 2pm. Tutored tastings can be arranged.
